- COVID Snapshot: Thank you for your continued daily symptom monitoring! For two consecutive weeks, our positive diagnoses have significantly decreased! As a reminder, this snapshot includes the number of students that today, Friday 10/1, are actively identified with a positive diagnosis, have been identified as a close contact status, and cumulative positive diagnosis cases since the beginning of the school year. We continue to rely on families to monitor symptoms daily and communicate with Bristol's Nurse as needed.
