- School Report Card: We are excited to see our 2020-21 School Report Card released next week! As part of the state accountability system, the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) produces report cards for every publicly funded school and district in Wisconsin. These report cards include data on multiple indicators for multiple years across four Priority Areas (Achievement, Growth, Target Group Outcomes, and On-track to Graduation). A school or district's overall accountability score places the school/district into one of five overall accountability ratings in the table below. As a district we continue to strive to significantly exceed expectations and look forward to the release of the school report card for the 2020-2021 school year.
