- **NEW! Bristol Lunchroom Supervisor Vacancy:** Bristol School is looking for lunchroom supervision help. - NEW! Act 20 Early Literacy Screenings: Beginning the week of 9/16 through the end of September, we will be administering early literacy screenings for students in 4K-2nd grade. While the state is allowing us to delay initial screenings until winter, Bristol School has opted to do a trial run to ensure we are ready for full compliance later this year. After the screening, families will be notified of their child's progress in specific areas of early literacy. An early literacy night will be held later in the fall with more information for families.
- **NEW! WI Forward Individual Student Reports:** We will be sending individual student reports (ISRs) home next week with students in grades 4-7 who took the Forward exam at Bristol in spring of 2024. Please take time to review the assessment results to see how your child performed on the assessment. Remember that the ISR is just one of many indicators of your child's academic performance. In order to obtain a more complete picture of your child's areas of strength and growth, it is important to consider information from a variety of sources.
