Important Reminders:

- REMINDER! Halloween Costumes: As Halloween approaches please keep the following expectations in mind before you send your student
 to school. Any costumes or dress up should be school appropriate, comply with all school rules, and be free from religious, political or socially
 controversial themes. There is an expectation that masks and props will not be worn or used during class, learning time, transitions, lunch or
 recess, but are welcome at classroom or grade level celebrations. No props or costumes should have weapons, and any props, masks,
 costumes deemed inappropriate will be asked to be removed.
- REMINDER! ATOD Awareness Poster and Slogan Contests Opportunities: This year's Kenosha County ATOD winning slogan is "To Be Drug Free, It Takes TENACITY!" As done in previous years, school counselors will provide Bristol students an opportunity to participate in the ATOD Awareness Poster and Slogan Contests during classroom lessons.
